Each submission must include the following:

- Completed Submission Form
- Artist Statement
- Images (maximum of 3)
- Registration and Handling Fee payable to 'South Dublin Arts Centre Company'

This year the RUA RED curatorial team will select one artist from the successful applicants for a 4 week, solo show in Gallery 2 during 2011 (dates tbc).

There is a check list on the front of the Proposal form for your reference. Please note that only complete proposals including all requested information will be reviewed.

If you wish your materials to be returned to you, please enclose an SAE.

19th July – 21st August

An exhibition featuring a cross section of emerging and established artists presenting painting, printmaking, sculpture, photography, installation, mixed media work. All works for sale.

DATES FOR ARTISTS

Submission deadline	14 th June 2010
Delivery of work by artists	13 th / 14 th July 2010 (as advised)
Preview	17 th July 2010 (3pm – 5pm)
Removal of works	24 th August 2010

INFORMATION FOR ARTISTS

One artist selected for this year's Open will be offered a 4 week solo exhibition in Gallery 2 in 2011 (dates TBC).

All works submitted for exhibition are considered by RUA RED's Curatorial Team whose decision to accept or reject is final.

NUMBER AND SIZE OF WORKS

Artists may submit three works no larger than 1.5m in any one direction (outer frame size)

REGISTRATION FEE

A Registration and Handling Fee of €10 (inclusive of VAT) is required for **each work**. This payment must be submitted with the application form. No work will be considered without payment.

Cheques should be made to 'South Dublin Arts Centre Company'.

DEADLINE

Completed application forms and payment must be received at RUA RED by 5pm on Monday 14th June 2010.

RECEIVING DAYS

Tuesday 13th July 2010 10am - 6pm

Wednesday 14th July 2010, 10am - 6pm

Artists will be informed if their application was successful within 2 weeks of the closing date. All work chosen must be delivered to RUA RED, Tallaght, Dublin 24. Work will be received only between the stated hours, after which under no circumstances will any work be received without prior permission of RUA RED.

SALE OF WORK

All sales are subject to 25% commission during the continuance of the exhibition. All sales are managed by RUA RED. The price stated on the application form is the total price payable by the purchaser.

REMOVAL OF WORKS

Tuesday 24th August 2010, 10am - 6pm

After the Exhibition closes, works must be removed by Tuesday 24th August 2010. Work can be collected only between the stated hours, after which under no circumstances will any work be collected without prior permission of RUA RED.
