As a charity seeking donations from the public Rua Red, South Dublin Arts Centre, aims to comply with the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public

- Rua Red, South Dublin Arts Centre, is committed to complying with the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public and has formally discussed and adopted the Guidelines at a meeting of the governing body
- Rua Red, South Dublin Arts Centre, confirms its commitment to the principles set out in the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public by a statement to that effect in its annual report
- Rua Red, South Dublin Arts Centre, has a Donor Charter which is consistent with the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public
- Rua Red, South Dublin Arts Centre, regularly monitors compliance with the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public and compliance reports are received regularly by the governing body
- Rua Red, South Dublin Arts Centre, considers the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public when planning all fundraising activity
- Rua Red, South Dublin Arts Centre, has a policy on working with third party fundraisers (if applicable)
- Rua Red, South Dublin Arts Centre, provides honest, open, accountable and transparent disclosure when fundraising from the public
- Rua Red, South Dublin Arts Centre, has appointed a member of the governing body and/or a senior member of staff to be responsible for compliance with the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public
- Rua Red, South Dublin Arts Centre, ensures that fundraising staff are provided with information and training on the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public and its implementation
- Rua Red, South Dublin Arts Centre, has a feedback and complaints procedure consistent with the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public. Feedback is recorded for review by relevant staff including the CEO and governing body. Feedback is responded to promptly and appropriately
- Rua Red, South Dublin Arts Centre, prepares financial reports consistent with the requirements of the Charities Act 2009 and the Charities Regulator which include a statement concerning the extent to which control of the organisation is independent of its funding sources
