

# WINTER OPEN 2019 SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

## Call for submissions

Rua Red Annual open exhibition of fine and applied arts. Submissions may be in any discipline: painting, sculpture, new media, digital, printmaking, ceramics, glass, photography, installation and jewelry.

This open submission is an opportunity for graduates, emerging and established artists from Ireland (including the North of Ireland) to exhibit their work in Gallery 1.

Exhibition dates: 20<sup>th</sup> December 2019 - 24<sup>th</sup> January 2020

The overall winner of the Rua Red Art Prize will be awarded a solo show in Gallery 2 at some point during the ensuing 12 month period.

Rua Red has a policy of supporting artists at all stages of their career. One of the new ways that Rua Red will implement this policy will be to select and purchase works from the Winter Open and Café Wall exhibition to form a collection for the organisation. The works will go on show within the building on a rotational basis in the Conference and Meeting Room areas.

*All works submitted for exhibition are considered by a Selection Panel.*

Artists can submit a maximum of three works. Each submission must include the following:

- Completed Submission Form
- Images (maximum of 3)
- Registration and Handling Fee payable to 'South Dublin Arts Centre Company'

Completed application forms and payment must be received at Rua Red by **5pm on Friday, 27th September 2019**

### Registration Fee

A Registration and Handling Fee of €10 (inclusive of VAT) is required for each completed submission form with 3 images.

**Number of Works**

Artists may submit a maximum of three works for consideration. Submissions may be in any discipline, including but not limited to: painting, sculpture, new media, digital, printmaking, ceramics, glass, photography, installation and jewelry.

**Sale of Work**

All sales are subject to 25% commission during the continuance of the exhibition. All sales are managed by Rua Red. **NB** The price stated on the application form is the total price payable by the purchaser (to include 25% commission).
