Rua Red, South Dublin Arts Centre, is looking to establish a small panel of **Freelance Technical Assistants** to provide technical support for a wide range of small to medium events, primarily on Saturdays and evenings.

The successful candidates will be responsible for setting up and operating equipment for performances, talks, workshops, screenings, gigs, community events and acting as the main technical contact during these events.

This role would suit someone who is reliable, practical, calm under pressure, and confident working independently with artists, audiences, technical equipment and live events.

Duties could include:

- Proficient in lighting consoles and digital mixing consoles with experience using QLab or similar software
- Operating mechanical rig systems for safe adjusting, loading, and unloading of equipment
- Supporting performers with stage set-up, including vocal mics, instrument mics, guitar and bass amps, drum kits, foldback monitors, and simple sound checks.
- Setting up and operating AV equipment for talks, film screenings, presentations, and hybrid events.
- Identifying and resolving basic technical issues before and during events.
- Ensure that health and safety, operation and good house-keeping standards are practiced and followed, ensure the theatre and all equipment reverts to place post event
- Knowledge of current Health and Safety requirements relevant to the industry is essential.

We are especially interested in hearing from people with experience in live sound, theatre, visual art, film screenings, music events or community arts spaces. You do not need to be a senior technician, but you should be confident managing the technical requirements of small to medium-scale events independently.

This is a freelance position with flexible hours, offered on an as-needed basis.
